**POLICE DEPARTMENT—Chief McNeece gave a brief report. There was discussion on the on-line In-Service. Alderman Parmley made a motion to allow the police officers to do their In-Service on line for a fee of \$100.00 each. Alderman Orr seconded the motion and it passed 5/0.**

**FIRE DEPARTMENT—Chief Phillips discussed the policy on burn permits. This process will continue as in the past. Alderman Parmley made a motion to purchase a light bar not to exceed \$1000.00. Alderman Powell seconded the motion and it passed 5/0.**

passed 5/0.**


**KITCHEN AT CITY HALL—Alderman Parmley made a motion to put in

and it passed 5/0.**


**CITIZEN'S HEARING**
