Mayor Marilyn Campbell Nixon called the special meeting to order according to TCA 6-3-106 (4) (A), at 8:00 am in the conference room at city hall. There was a suspension of an employee for not following the personal policy and protocol. This was based on several meetings with the employee at which Alderman Orr was present. The suspension was without pay for three days.

Joy Sturtevant, city recorder, presented the council with her resignation effective September 17, 2010. Alderman Powell asked that the resignation be changed to be effective immediately. Alderman Powell made the motion to accept Ms. Sturtevant's resignation effective July 6, 2010. Alderman Orr seconded the motion with the addition that her insurance be extended until September 1, 2010 upon approval of Blue Cross & Blue Shield and that all vacation time properly accrued be paid, less time actually taken. At this time the council gave Ms. Sturtevant time to address the issues. There was a roll call vote with the motion passing 5/0.
