Alderman Gipson would like to discuss the money owed to the city by 911 at the workshop and to schedule another meeting with the 911 board.

PAVING OF CHICKORY LN – Marion County Highway Department will pave Chickory Ln for \$ 13,009.50. After discussion Alderman Blalock made a motion to have this street paved. Alderman Terrill seconded the motion and it passed 4/1 with the mayor not voting.
