The Monteagle City Council meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Mayor Rodman. After the prayer and the pledge of allegiance Alderman Parmley made a motion to approve minutes of the Public Hearing and regular meeting of June 27, 2022 and Special Meeting of July 18, 2022. Alderman Favaloro seconded the motion and it passed 5/0.

UTILITY – Mr. John Condra reported that the lake level is 9' 8". Mr. Travis Wilson gave an update on the capacity test and that the information that is being gathered should be ready by late August. They are working as quickly as possible. He is tracking the ARP grants and working with SETDD. We are not under a moratorium. The town is being proactive and not letting anyone outside the city hoop to the water system.

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POLICE DEPARTMENT – Officer Donnie Burnette was present to give the report.

FIRE DEPARTMENT – Travis Lawyer Fire Chief and Codes Enforcement Officer was present to give the report. The agreement with the Sewanee Fire Department is on file. Mr. Will Foehing questioned a complaint that has been filed on RBT. No burn permit is required at this time.

STREETS – Mr. Keith Butner reported that he is waiting for the Marion County Road Commissioner to give him prices for Laurel Lake Drive. Also, the Boom Mower is being donated to the city but we will have to get it repaired.

FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE 11-22—An ordinance to amend section 501 of the zoning ordinance for the town to include apartments as a use granted upon approval of a special exception in C-2, per section 1107. Alderman Wilson made a motion to approve this ordinance on first reading. Alderman Powell seconded the motion and it passed 5/0.

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Alderman Wilson reported that he is working with Police Chief Jared Nunley on a pay scale and a policy for next year's budget.

Alderman Favaloro thanked the utility workers for putting the gravel on the walking trail behind City Hall.

Alderman Pamley gave a list of all the events going on in the city.

There being no other business Alderman Powell made a motion to adjourn. Alderman Parmley seconded the motion and it passed 5/0.
